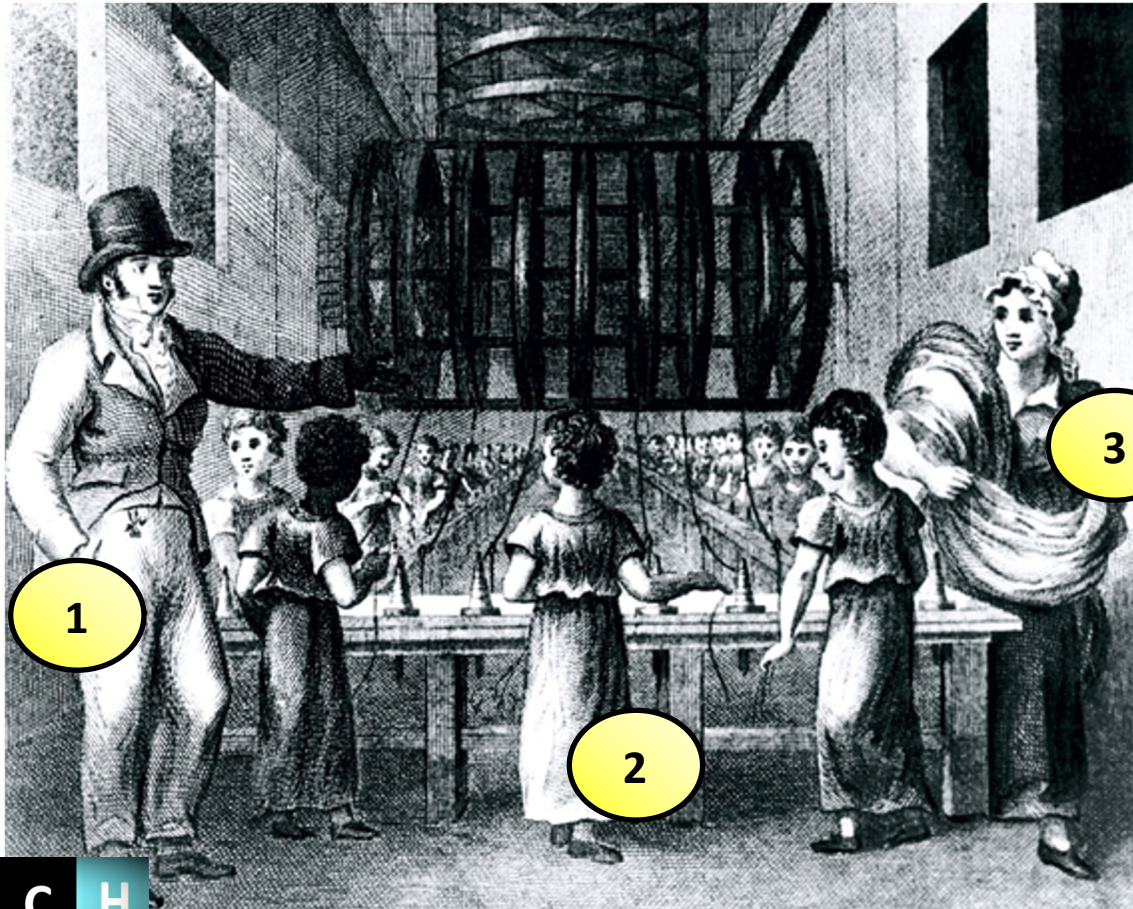


# Children in Factories
