


### **President**

#### **President Jefferson Davis**



Davis attended military school and placed 23rd out of his class of 34. He later fought bravely in the Mexican War of 1848 and was offered a promotion.

He refused military promotion + was elected to the U.S. Senate. Very popular in the South but impatient with those who disagreed with him.




Robert E. Lee He was considered the best general in the USA. Lee refused Lincoln's offer to lead the Union + led the


